

Understanding Reading Levels

This grid translates the Department of Educations reading levels to grade levels.

Grade levels are written as the grade and month separated by a decimal point. 1.8 would be the equivalent of the first grade, 8th month.

With our program, your child will become a **skilled and confident reader** in a year or less. Ready to get started? The next step is a free reading assessment; it takes about an hour and is free of charge. It will provide you with an accurate picture of your child's reading ability.
